

The Swiss Dramatherapy Institute (dramatherapie.ch Bildungsinstitut GmbH)

is an educational organisation that provides training, practice, supervision and counselling in dramatherapy with the aim of developing and expanding the field of dramatherapy in Switzerland.

The institute is an offspring and a member of the Swiss Dramatherapy Association (Verein dramatherapie.ch), both of them initiated by Brigitte Spörri Weilbach with the support of Dr. Susana Pendzik and other internationally acknowledged dramatherapists, such as Dr. Sue Jennings, Prof. Dr. Mooli Lahad, Alida Gersie, Anna Chesner and Doris Müller-Weith.

The institute offers a three-year modular training program in dramatherapy for professionals in the psychosocial, educational, medical, and theatre fields. In addition, it provides special courses in therapeutic theatre, as well as continuing education and supervision for trained dramatherapists and other creative arts therapists.

The program is approved by the Swiss Creative Arts Therapies Association KSKV-CASAT, leading to the federal exam for the professional diploma in dramatherapy. The program is done in cooperation with the Swiss-French Institute *Créavie* (www.creavie.ch)

The institute is distinguished by its international character deriving from the international teaching team as well as from the Swiss intercultural context. Courses are taught in English, German and French (with translation if needed).
